



SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM

Around the World in 8 Weeks

Week 1 : Welcome to the World! (Global Kick-off)

Date: 30 June - 4 July



Games:

"Travel Around the World" – Place mats or pictures of different countries around the play area. Kids hop from one to another while music plays.

"Where Are We Going?" – Pretend to fly an airplane, sail a boat, or ride a train to different places.

Crafts:

"My Travel Passport" – Decorate a pretend passport with stamps/stickers.

"Handprint World Map" – Kids create a world map with different handprint colors for continents.

Activities:

Play with Globes & Maps – Let children explore a soft globe or giant world map.

Practice Saying 'Hello' – Learn simple greetings in different languages.

Field Trip: Museum of Science and Technology

Week 2: African Safari (Kenya & Egypt Focus)

Date: 7 July - 11 July



Games:

"Animal Safari Hunt" – Hide toy animals around the yard for kids to find.

"Lions & Zebras" – One child is the lion, and the zebras have to run to the safe zone before being tagged.

Crafts:

Animal Masks – Make paper plate lion, elephant, or zebra masks.

Beaded Bracelets – Use colorful beads to make Maasai-style jewelry.

Activities:

Drumming Circle – Play on small buckets like African drums.

"Walk Like an Animal" Game – Kids move like giraffes, elephants, or hippos.

Sand Play "Egyptian Pyramids" – Build simple sand pyramids.

Field Trip: Belgrade Zoo

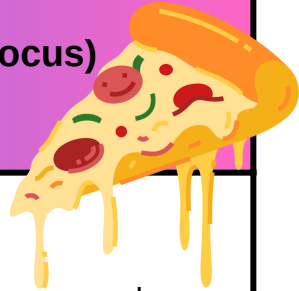

Week 3: European Fun (France & Italy Focus)

Date: 14 July - 18 July



Games:

"Eiffel Tower Building" – Stack blocks to see who can make the tallest tower.

"Pasta Sorting" – Use dry pasta in different shapes and have kids sort them by type.

Crafts:

Mini Pizzas – Kids add toppings to small pre-made dough circles.

Paint a Paris Scene – Use watercolor to create the Eiffel Tower or a French café.

Activities:

Simple Ballet Lesson – Move like little dancers in France.

Make Playdough "Bread" – Pretend to be bakers and shape croissants or baguettes.

Field Trip: Kalemegdan - Chocolate Factory

Week 4: Magical Asia (China & Japan Focus)

Date: 21 July - 25 July



Games:

"Dragon Dance" – Kids hold onto a long fabric and pretend to be a dragon moving through the room.

"Chopstick Challenge" – Use tongs to pick up soft pom-poms.

Crafts:

Paper Lanterns – Fold and decorate simple paper lanterns.

Origami Fish – Use bright colors to fold simple fish.

Activities:

Rice Sensory Play – Fill a tub with dry rice and small treasures.

Practice Bowing – Learn the polite bowing greeting from Japan.

Field Trip: Botanical Garden

Week 5: South America Adventure (Brazil & Peru)

Date: 28 July - 1 August



Games:

"Amazon Rainforest Animal Sounds" – Play a sound-matching game with jungle animal noises.

"Jump Like a Frog" – See who can hop the farthest like an Amazon tree frog!

Crafts:

Colorful Carnival Masks – Decorate with feathers and glitter.

Parrot Handprint Art – Use bright paint for handprint parrots.

Activities:

Carnival Dance Party – Use scarves or ribbons and dance to lively music.

Pretend to Climb Machu Picchu – Have kids step up small cushions pretending to climb.

Field Trip: Ada Ciganlija

Week 6: North America Fun (USA & Mexico Focus)

Date: 4 August - 8 August



Games:

"Pin the Star on the Flag" – Like "Pin the Tail on the Donkey," but with an American flag.

"Mexican Hat Dance" – Play fun music and dance around a sombrero.

Crafts:

Mini Piñatas – Decorate small paper bags and fill them with soft treats.

Dreamcatchers – Use yarn and paper plates to create simple dreamcatchers.

Activities:

Watermelon Seed Spitting Contest – See how far kids can "spit" a seed (or just pretend!).

Make Maracas – Fill plastic eggs with beans and shake to the music.

Week 7: Oceanic Wonders (Australia & Hawaii)

Date: 11 August - 15 August



Games:

"Kangaroo Hop Race" – Kids hop with a small stuffed animal between their knees.

"Coconut Bowling" – Roll a ball (coconut pretend) to knock down water bottles.

Crafts:

Boomerangs – Decorate paper boomerangs with Aboriginal dot art.

Tissue Paper Ocean Collage – Create a big blue ocean scene.

Activities:

Hula Dancing – Practice simple Hawaiian hand movements.

Pretend to Surf – Balance on a soft board on the ground.

Field Trip: Tropicarium

Week 8: Grand Finale – World Celebration!

Date: 18 August - 22 August



Games:

"Musical World Tour" – Play music from different countries, and kids dance in different styles.

"Pass the Globe" – Like "Hot Potato," but using a small globe ball.

Crafts:

World Flags Banners – Make and hang small flags from different countries.

"My Favorite Country" Drawing – Kids pick their favorite week and draw it.

Activities:

Parade of Nations – Kids dress up in costumes or colors of different countries.

World Feast – Try small tastes of simple snacks from different cultures.
